## WHAT ARE WE UP TO?

In October 2007, **THE HOMEOPATHIC CENTRE** of our **4KENIA** Foundation will be opened wide to the locals of the Kwale District in Kenya – tens of thousands helpless denizens of the bush South of Mombasa, who are, like in many other remote areas of this enormous country, badly in need of permanent and substantial health care.

We have installed up-to-date **CLINICAL FACILITIES**, as well as a **MEDICAL LAB** for extensive research into the battles against AIDS and malaria (both fatal diseases with almost epidemical proportions in this area), and for production of all necessary homeopathic medication. Our initial professional staff consists of 3 Kenyan and at least 20 Dutch qualified homeopaths, to be joined in the near future by 10 more specialists in this field.

**4KENIA** is also running its own **MOBILE CLINIC** for visiting bush schools, where Kwale youngsters can be treated and/or educated on the spot (e.g. family planning!).

What's more, we are accomodating 16 orphan girls from Kwale, who will be trained as **HOMEOPATHIC NURSES** in a full-time, free-of-charge 2-year curriculum. With this project, we are helping these girls to a better, purposeful life, and simultaneously creating opportunities for the local population to run this kind of Health Centres independently at a later stage.

International students and homeopaths will also be most welcome on our premises: for them we have created separate **TRAINEE FACILITIES**.





## WHY HOMEOPATHY?

Even in our hi-tech age, most needy Kenyans are dependent on just two medical institutions: the bush doctor or the hospital. The largest part of the poor country people are seeking help with the bush doctors, but their facilities are limited, of course. Better equipped hospitals, on the other hand, are mostly not only too far away (often at several days' walking distance), but also unaffordable.

**4KENIA** is going to bridge this gap in health care. Our homeopathic centre represents an ideal, sophisticated supplement to existing methods, using local raw material and knowledge to provide highly effective, yet extremely low-priced medical assistance.



## WHY ORPHAN GIRLS?

Initially, our two-year training course has been set up for orphan girls, who represent an alarmingly large, and all too often neglected segment of Kenyan society. Since *women* are generally considered as “Africa’s Future”, we decided to improve their lives in the first place, and to create opportunities for them to dedicate their new knowledge to the needs of their own people. Our orphan girls are mostly left-alone children from families who were exterminated by fatal diseases themselves, and are therefore highly motivated to look after the well-being of others. We are giving them the know-how... They received their basic education from the Verkaar Foundation (the Dutch Foreign Aid bureau which has built and staffed no less than 70 schools in the area since 1989), and even in this early stage it is quite encouraging to witness the full devotion with which these ladies apply themselves to the **4KENIA** initiatives...

## WHO'S PAYING?

In realizing our Centre, 4KENIA co-operates with the Development Team of the Verkaart Foundation, and with the Dutch Homeopathic School in Amersfoort. Half of our budget is covered by NCDO, the Dutch governmental Foreign Aid bureau; the other half will be produced through fund raising, special events, collections and donations.

Continuous expansion of our starting budget, however, is one of our highest priorities: the more we receive, the more we can spend on improving the conditions of life among the Kwale population – with, in our case, a special focus on the underprivileged orphan kids of Kenya. Initial success in the Kwale District will guarantee our further plans for the establishment of many more similar clinics elsewhere in Kenya – and maybe even in other developing countries...
